Russian cellist Maria Tchaikovskaya was a first-prize winner of the International Pablo Casals Competition in Budapest (1968) and studied with Mstislav Rostropovich.

An active performer, she currently teaches at the Moscow State Conservatory. As an orchestra soloist, she has performed classical and modern repertoire in Germany, England, France, Poland, Greece and the US. She holds a special place among Russian cellists for her meditative interpretations, beautiful velvety sound, virtuosity and individuality. She will perform works by Schumann, Britten and Shostakovitch.
