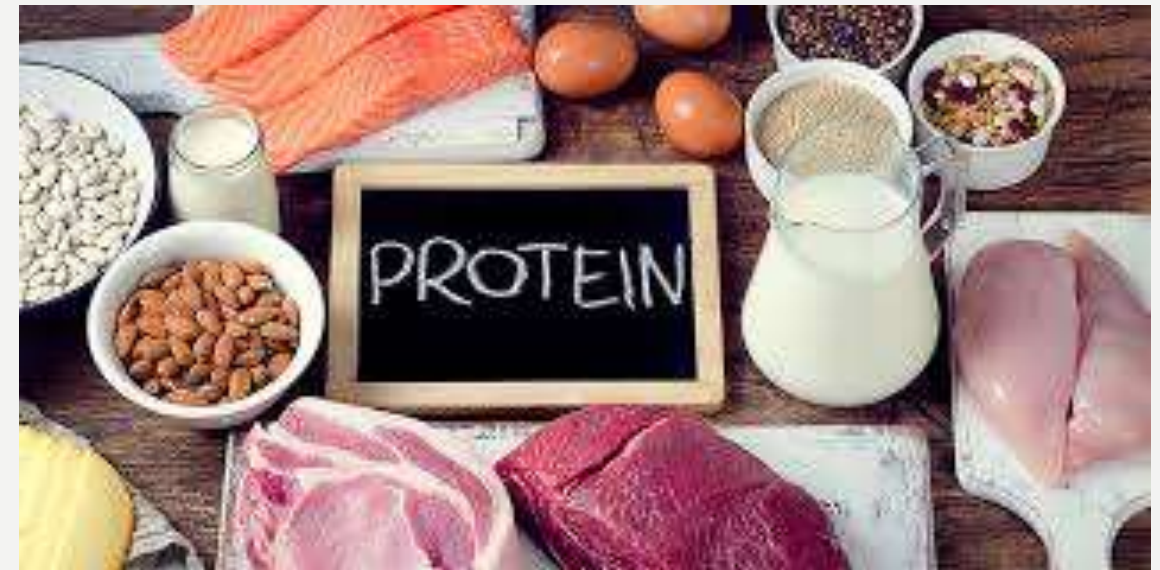

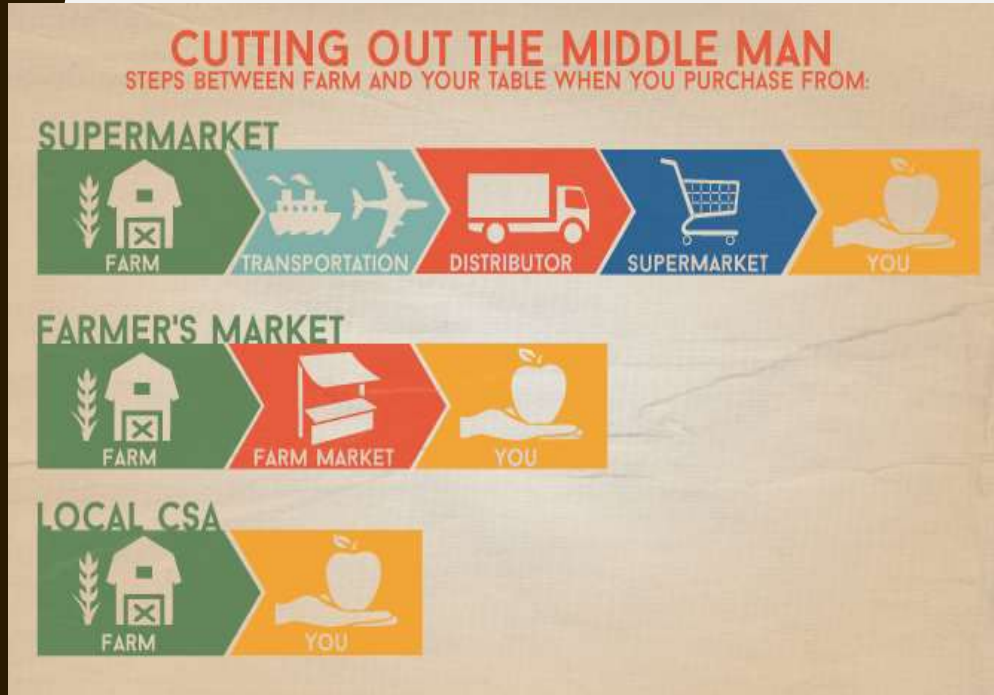

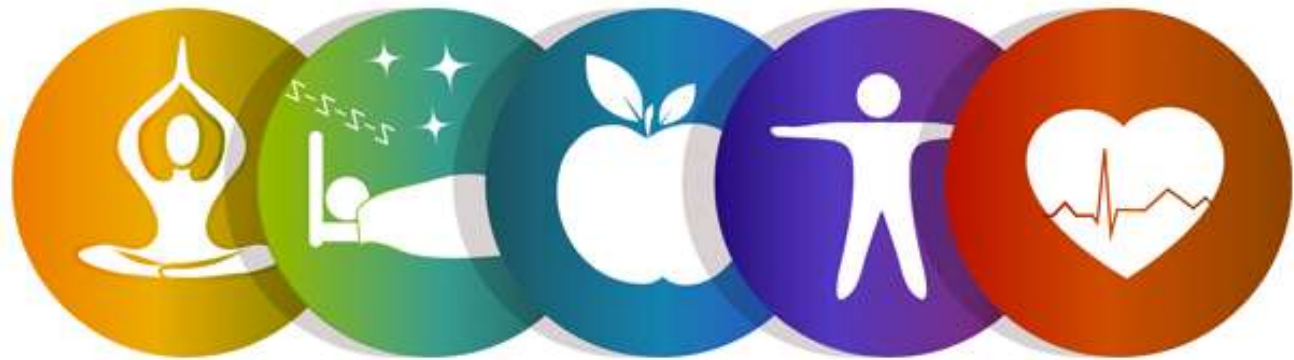

STUDENTS HAVE TWO OPTIONS WHEN APPLYING

Nutrition and Food Science Degree

- Dietetics concentration (registered dietician nutritionist track) *restricted*
- Applied Nutrition and Wellness concentration
- Food Science concentration
- Food Systems concentration

BS/MS Nutrition and Food Science Degree

- Available in every concentration
- 4+1 program, students take graduate courses in their senior year and complete Master's degree in 5th year
- Students pay undergraduate tuition for first 12 graduate credits
- Students graduate with a BS and MS degree

APPLY TO DIETETICS IN SOPHOMORE OR JUNIOR YEAR

Requirements to apply

- 1. Complete the following four courses
 - CHEM113 (Fundamentals of Chemistry with lab)
 - MATH109 (Statistics)
 - NUFD150 (Food Comp and Scientific Prep)
 - NUFD192 (Nutrition with Lab)
- 2. Achieve a minimum overall GPA at Montclair State of 3.2.

As long as students meet application requirements they will be admitted into Dietetics, once admitted, students cannot be removed from the program.

The Department of Nutrition and Food Studies is responding to the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics elevated educational requirements
