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POLICY ON THE USE OF STUDENT CLINICIANS TO PROVIDE SERVICE TO OUR CLIENTS

The Center for Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology is an integral part of the teaching and research programs of Montclair State University. All services at the Center are performed by graduate students working under the supervision of qualified faculty and clinical staff.

Evaluations, therapy and counseling sessions may be observed by students directly or by way of a secure video system. In addition, sessions will be recorded using the same video system for use by students and their instructors as part of student education. Student observations will not interfere with the high-quality clinical service that is provided by the student clinicians and supervised by the faculty and clinical staff.

In view of the foregoing, the Center *can only provide clinical services for individuals* who are willing to cooperate with the educational and research activities (if separate consent is provided) of the Center.

By signing this form, I acknowledge that I have read the above statement and agree that the services:

- may be rendered to me or my child by graduate students under the supervision of clinical staff and/or department faculty.
- in which I and/or my child participate may be viewed by students at the Center and may be recorded on a secure video system that will be used to meet the needs of the teaching and research missions of the Center
