### **We Hope You Are Planning to Return in the Fall.**

In order to return as a student, you need to register for courses and submit payment within the payment deadlines\*.

What happens if you register and do not make payment by the deadline?  
The answer is called **“DE-REGISTRATION.”**

**“De-registration” is the process of removing you from all your selected courses and making your seat(s) available to other students.**

Once you are de-registered you need to start the process from the beginning and there is no guarantee that the classes you want may still be available.

Try not to let this happen.

#### **Helpful Hints:**

- 1) Don't wait until the last minute to register and pay your bill.
- 2) Check your Account Summary (bill) on WESS to determine that everything is current and that you do not have any holds.
- 3) Make certain that your federal financial aid form (FAFSA) has been filed and received by the Student Financial Aid Office.
- 4) If the Student Financial Aid office needs additional information or documentation; get it to them as soon as possible. This is where many students cause themselves to miss deadlines.
- 5) If you are planning not to return, make certain that you drop your courses on WESS and pay all outstanding bills.
- 6) Undergraduate students must also formally withdraw from the University through the Center for Advising & Student Transitions in Morehead Hall. This will allow you the opportunity to return in the future or to have transcripts sent to other schools or employers.
