Application Requirements for Scholars

English Language Requirements:

Meet the university's English proficiency requirement (exceptions may be made if you are a native speaker or received a degree from an English-speaking country):

- TOEFL iBT minimum score 70
- IELTS minimum score 6.0
- Duolingo minimum score 95
- Pearson PTE-A minimum score 48
- ITEP minimum score 3.7
- English3 J-1 English Interview minimum score 3.0
- Language Certificate demonstrating B2 Level or higher based on the European Framework

Health Insurance Requirement:

The U.S. Department of State requires all exchange visitors (both J-1 principals and J-2 dependents; students and scholars) to have coverage for accident and medical insurance, medical evacuation, and repatriation of remains in effect for the duration of their exchange visitor program. A willful failure to carry insurance is considered to be a violation of federal regulations and will result in loss of immigration status. For more information see our <u>Health Insurance page</u>.

Funding:

You must show a minimum of \$2,000 per month for living expenses and estimate approximately \$650 per dependent per month. Proof of funding is required in the form of a copy of an official bank statement from yourself or your sponsor showing a history of debits and credits, or a letter of sponsorship from your university, scholarship organization, or government. *All financial documentation must be current (no more than 2 months old) and in English.*
