Accessing Your Network File Shares from Your Personal Machine via WebDav

Please note: The following procedure should always be used to access your file shares when you are accessing your files from your personal computer or another non-MSU lab machine.


Mapping Your File Share

First, determine the file share you want to access from the list below:

- 1. Right-click on This PC
- 2. Click on Map network drive....



3. Specify the appropriate **Drive** letter for the Directory Address

(N:) is your personal (home) file share (W:) is your web publishing file share

- 4. Type in the Directory Addresses from above in the Folder: field
- 5. Check Connect using different credentials
- 6. Click Finish
