



Estimated Cost of Attendance Fall 2020 and Spring 2021 for Graduate Students

The Code of Federal Regulations requires Montclair State University to verify that prospective students have sufficient funds to be able to live and study in the U.S. for their first year of study before being issued an I-20 (F-1 students). In order to receive a Form I-20, students must submit documentation of financial support in the amount listed for estimated total. The tables below describe the estimated minimum cost of living in the U.S. and studying at Montclair State University for 9 months (one academic year). These estimates do not include the cost of living and studying in the summer; if you plan to remain in the U.S. during the summer, you will need to ensure you have additional funds for tuition and fees, living expenses, and miscellaneous expenses.
