New in-state undergraduates with less than 12 credits are charged \$233.05 per credit, including fees, per semester. Continuing undergraduates may choose the new flat rate plan or continue with a \$218.06 per credit, including fees, charge.

\*\* Starting in fall '02, newly entering full-time out-of-state undergraduate students are charged a flat rate charge per semester, fees are additional. Full-time is defined as 12 or more credits. New out-of-state undergraduates with less than 12 credits are charged \$355.26 per credit, including fees, per semester. Continuing undergraduates may choose the new flat rate plan or continue with a \$334.78 per credit, including fees, charge.

\*\*\* In fall 1999, graduate tuition reflects the newly added Ed.D and M.F.A. programs. A new M.B.A. tuition also began in fall 1999.
