MR. BRUNS was a senior official with the Smithsonian Institution serving as curator of postal history and philately; Founding Director of the National Postal Museum, Director of Operations; Under Secretary for American Museums and National Programs, serving as the principal deputy to the Under Secretary for American Museums and National Programs with responsibility for policy, planning, programs and operational matters of nine museums, four national programs and three cultural initiatives with combined annual budgets in excess of \$150 million; and served as chief development officer for the Smithsonian Institution. Subsequent to his tenure at the Smithsonian Institution, Mr. Bruns served as the President of the Theodore Roosevelt Association, a national historical society and public service organization chartered by a special Act of Congress in 1920 to perpetuate the legacy of Theodore Roosevelt and was the President and Chief Executive Officer of the Atlanta Historical Society, which includes the Atlanta History Center and the Margaret Mitchell House and Museum. Mr. Bruns is the author of ten books on postal history and philately and has published several hundred articles related to these subjects.
