Study Abroad returns with strong numbers and SOAR access scholarships

We are so pleased to share that student interest in study abroad programs has been extremely strong! Our office has had a constant flow of students who are looking to learn more about study abroad and we are thrilled to meet with them. Please continue sending them to see us in Cole 349.

The increased interest pairs well with our new S.O.A.R. scholarships (Study abroad Opportunity and Access Resources), offered for the first time with funding secured by the Provost's Office. In this pilot year, the SOAR Committee is awarding \$1000 for faculty-led programs and \$3000 for Spring 2023 semester programs. There is another application deadline of Feb. 1st, 2023 for summer 2023 programs, with \$2000 awards available. Designated for students with demonstrated financial need, SOAR awards help bring study abroad within the financial reach of many more students.

Visiting Scholars Program Resumes

After being suspended during the worst of the Covid-19 pandemic, the Montclair State Visiting Scholars Program resumed as of September 1st, 2022. Through this program, our faculty can initiate an application for an international scholar to visit their department and participate in research, teaching, and/or workshop activity, which is mutually beneficial to our university and the visiting scholar.
