- B) I want to study in South Korea, Scotland, Austria, Iceland, Costa Rica, Morocco, Germany, Greece, India, or Italy
- C) I want to study in a new part of the United States, Canada, Guam, Puerto Rico, or the U.S. Virgin Islands.

What kind of environment would you enjoy studying in the most?

If you chose mostly A:

You should research our **Faculty Led Programs.** Faculty-Led Short
Term Programs are either 7-14 day
opportunities embedded within a
semester course, or stand alone
summer courses, led by Montclair
State University faculty members.
These are low cost programs that
change annually.

If you chose mostly C:

You should research our National Student Exchange Program (NSE). This program provides accessible collegiate study away to undergraduate students at over 160 member colleges and universities in the United States, Canada, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands.
