What to Expect from a Remote Site Visit

Before the Visit

- Once your district has agreed to participate, our research coordinator will work with your school liaison to schedule the details of our visit: the date(s), the school/district staff members that will be interviewed, and any contact information needed for virtual interviews and focus groups.
- Our research coordinator will set up virtual meetings and send all participants the necessary information to provide informed consent and join their scheduled meetings.

During the Visit

•	Our 3-4 member research team will spend the school day conducting Zoom
	interviews and/or focus groups with faculty and administrators in your district
	including:
	a sample of secondary science teachers (0-3 years of experience),
	a sample of secondary science teachers (4+ years of experience),
	mentors for secondary science teachers new to the district,
	science department supervisor or equivalent,
	mentoring/induction program leader for the district/school,
	other faculty or administrator(s) involved in supporting new teachers
•	Participants will have the option to join and participate in remote meetings with or
	without activating their webcams

After the Visit

- You will receive a certificate of participation as well as a summary of our analysis
 and press release about your district's success in retention that you can share with
 your school community, Board of Education, and local papers.
- A representative from your district will be invited to attend a culminating conference on science teacher retention at Montclair State University in 2023.
