

Exercise: Round-Robin Quote, Paraphrase, Contextualize

1. Find a key quote from “ ”. Write it down with an appropriate introduction (for example—“In _____, so-so says ‘. . .’”)
2. Now paraphrase the quote and put it in context (for example—“What he means by this is that in. . .”)

Pass the paper. New group—Read what has been written.

3. Find a quote (or piece of info, statistic, etc.) that adds to the idea contained in the first quote. Paraphrase it using an appropriate transitional introduction (Write only the paraphrase with correct citation!!).
4. Add a sentence that explains the connection between the 2 quotes.

5. Write a 2 sentence conclusion for this paragraph.
6. Read the paragraph aloud to your group. Do you agree or disagree with what has been written? What is the paragraph/discussion missing?
