SUPPORTING THE EVENT AND EVENING DETAILS:

Q: What time does the event start?

A: Check-In begins at 6:30 pm. Signs will direct guests from Red Hawk Parking Deck.

Q: Do I need to register or have a ticket to attend the event?

A: Yes. Registration is required to attend the event.

Q: What is the venue this year?

A: At 6:30 pm, a reception will begin in front of College Hall on Alumni Green under a large tent and around the area outside of College Hall. At approximately 7:45 pm, guests will walk a short distance to our outdoor amphitheater for the awards program, entertainment by our talented College of the Arts students and a special tribute to President Cole celebrating her 23-year legacy at Montclair State University. After the program, all are welcome back to the tent for a dessert reception.

Q: Can I donate to scholarships without attending?

Q: What if I registered but cannot attend on the day of the event?

A: A livestream link will be available on the event website on May 22. It will allow for viewing the program portion of the evening in our Amphitheater.

Q: Which restrooms will be open?

A: The restrooms in College Hall will be available for everyone.

Q: Is there a rain date?

A: No. A rain date has not been scheduled. In the event of inclement weather, we will be sharing a rain plan for the evening.

Q: Will ADA seating be available?

A: Yes. There will be designated seating at the Amphitheater to accommodate our guests.



Q: What is the recommended attire?

A: The majority of the event will take place outside and we recommend festive or comfortable attire that also includes comfortable shoes. Sneakers are welcome!

Q: Will the entire campus be open?

A: Yes, summer sessions begin on Monday, May 24.

SAFETY AT THE EVENT:

Q: Do I have to wear a mask at the event?

A: Wearing a mask outdoors is optional. Masks must be worn indoors. Please bring a cloth face covering with you and wear your mask whenever you are indoors.

Q: Will there be assigned seating for the program at the Amphitheater?

A: Yes, we will provide assigned seating for the amphitheater. Student ambassadors and ushers will be available to assist guests as needed.

Q: Will there be assigned seating for the reception portion of the event?

A: No, there are not assigned seats for the reception. We are providing many spacious areas under and around the tent for guests to sit, stand, and stroll throughout Alumni Green. There will be reserved cocktail tables for honorees and lead event sponsors.

Q: What is the expected attendance?

A: We are expecting up to 200 guests to join us to celebrate our honorees, President Cole and the importance of student scholarships.

Q: Are there any parts of the event that will be held indoors?

A: The College Hall Atrium will have a display of individually served hors d'oeuvres for guests to pick up and return outside to eat under the tent or at any of the tables in the surrounding areas.

Q: Will the University have COVID-19 pre-screening requirements before attending the event?

A: Yes. All Montclair State University campus visitors and staff are required to complete the MSU questionnaire, [Annual Scholarship Fundraiser Hawk Check](#), 6-14 hours prior to arrival on campus. All in attendance will be asked to display the email confirmation upon arrival. The email confirmation can be printed or displayed on a mobile device.

You will be asked to certify that you have read these guidelines and agree to abide by them when you complete the [Annual Scholarship Fundraiser Hawk Check](#) prior to your arrival.

For everyone's safety, if you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 or have COVID-19 symptoms, please do not attend the fundraiser and instead join our program [virtually](#).
