Matters Presented by the Chair – Mr. George J. Hiltzik

Mr. Hiltzik reported that in closed session the Trustees reviewed the minutes from October 25, 2017, reviewed legal matters, discussed contract negotiations, and personnel matters.

Matters Presented by the President – Dr. Susan A. Cole

Dr. Cole reported the University hired David Vernon as the Vice President for Human Resources and thanked Junea Edmund-Williams for serving as the Acting Vice President for Human Resources. Dr. Cole announced that Dean of the Graduate School Joan Ficke would be retiring from her role in the administration effective December 31st and that she would return to her position as a faculty member.
