Minutes from the meeting of December 16, 2016

Matters Presented by the Chair — Mr. Hiltzik

Mr. Hiltzik reported that the Board met in closed session prior to the meeting during which time they reviewed the minutes from December 16, 2016, received an update on legal matters, and received an update on media relations contracts.

Matters Presented by the President – Dr. Susan A. Cole

Dr. Cole reported that the University conferred 2,277 degrees at the January 25, 2017 Commencement ceremony. The renovation of Partridge Hall into the School of Nursing and Graduate School building has been completed. The renovation of Mallory Hall has begun, and, when completed, it will house the Computer Science and Information Technology programs. Physics Professor Marc Favata was honored with the National Science Foundation Early Career Award and Pankaj Lal, associate professor of Earth and Environmental Studies and associate director of the PSEG Institute for Sustainability received the Presidential Early Career Awards for Scientists. The University's annual scholarship dinner will be held on March 4, 2017.

Union Report

Professor Wolfson spoke on behalf of AFT Local 1904. Professor Wolfson congratulated the nine faculty appointments, 82 professional staff reappointments, and 21 second year faculty reappointments. Professor Wolfson thanked the Provost for granting 29 of the 40 sabbatical requests submitted. Professor Wolfson sought additional information regarding the contract awards and sought clarification regarding the rights and privileges of specialists. Professor Wolfson thanked the Trustees for their service to the University, stating that the Trustees take great interest in what is in the best interest of the University, including providing financial support.

Ms. Cali further moved that the Board of Trustees approve the execution of the Fifth Amendment to the Energy Sales Agreement and further direct that the University is authorized to take all actions necessary to implement the Energy Services Agreement as amended. Masters of Science in Business Analytics

Ms. Cali moved that the Montclair State University Board of Trustees approves the establishment of a Masters of Science in Business Analytics, effective September 2017. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

Masters of Science in Information Technology

Ms. Cali moved that the Montclair State University Board of Trustees approve the conversion of the existing concentration in Information Technology to a separate degree program, Masters of Science in Information Technology, effective September 2017. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.
