#### Union Report

Professor Richard Wolfson congratulated Mr. Hiltizik on being elected Chair of the Board of Trustees and thanked Mr. LaRossa for his outstanding leadership over the past four years. Professor Wolfson remarked that the new School of Business building is impressive and has provided faculty and staff the ability to serve their mission. Professor Wolfson congratulated the 23 new faculty members. Professor Wolfson stated he supported all the contract awards on the Board's agenda and raised a concern regarding faculty parking.

## Matters presented by the President — Dr. Cole

Dr. Cole announced that the University's enrollment was 20,465, which represented a 2% (443 students) increase over the same time last year. Dr. Cole stated that the graduation rate has grown at a higher rate than the enrollment, which was a great indicator that the University was successfully moving its students toward degree completion. Dr. Cole welcomed the new members of the faculty and staff and took note of the ribbon cutting for the School of Business building that was to take place later that afternoon, as well as the ribbon cutting for the Center for Environmental and Life Sciences, which will occur on October 13, 2015. She reported that construction was under way on the new School of Communications and Media, the renovation of Partridge Hall, which will house the new School of Nursing and the Graduate School, and the former Ward Trucking Building, which will serve as center for clinical services, training over 500 students once it opens in January 2016.
