Mr. Hiltzik called the meeting to order in the School of Communication, 1<sup>th</sup> Floor Presentation Hall, at 11:15 a.m.

Mark Fleming, Esq. swore in George Koutsouradis as the non-voting student trustee.

Roll call — As reported above.

Minutes from the meeting of June 8, 2017

Trustees approved the minutes from June 8, 2017 as distributed.

No. 3113

Union Report

Professor Wolfson spoke on behalf of AFT Local 1904. Professor Wolfson reported that there is a tentative agreement between the Union and the State of New Jersey, and the Union is pleased that the negotiations are completed. Professor Wolfson stated that he was pleased the State of New Jersey had designated Montclair State University a Public Research University, and he hoped that the faculty would receive the appropriate recognition. Professor Wolfson extended his congratulations to Dean Daniel Gurskis for receiving tenure, requested additional information regarding the annual budget, and urged the Board to approve the managerial raise pool. In closing, Professor Wolfson asked that be given prior information regarding any Board action on Dr. Cole’s compensation.

Audit, Finance and Investment Committee

Dr. Cuss reported that the Audit, Finance and Investment Committee reviewed the minutes from its meeting of June 8, 2017.

Contract award authorization

Dr. Cuss moved, on the recommendation of the Audit, Finance and Investment, and Academic Affairs and Facilities Committees, that the Board of Trustees authorize awarding of the following contracts:

- 35 Clove Road Interior Renovation (UniMak Construction) - \$4,575,900
- Student Center Quad Design Services (DI Group Architecture) - \$156,987
- Telecom Construction Services (CTCI) - \$500,000
- Academic Subscription (Standard and Poor's Investment Services) – \$48,284
- Academic Subscription (University of Pennsylvania) - \$46,894
- Hewlett Packard Data Storage Arrays (SHI, Inc. – HP Financial Services) - \$650,000
- Apple Computers (Apple, Inc.) - \$700,000

FY 2018 Tuition and Fees

Dr. Cuss moved that the Board of Trustees approve the tuition and fee rates for Fall 2017 through Summer 2018. The motion was seconded and approved by a vote of 8-1.

FY 2018 Meal plan and room rates

Dr. Cuss moved that the Board of Trustees approve the room and meal plan rates for Fall 2017 and Spring 2018. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

No. 3116

FY2018 Operating budget

Dr. Cuss moved that the Board of Trustees approve the fiscal year 2018 operating budget for Montclair State University. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

No. 3117

Academic Affairs and Facilities Committee

Ms. Cali reported that the Committee reviewed the minutes from its June 8, 2017 meeting, received a capital project report, reviewed the Clery report for June, and reviewed contract award authorizations that the Audit, Finance, and Investment Committee will present for action by the full Board.

Energy Sales Agreement Change Order

Ms. Cali moved that the President and Vice President for Finance and Treasurer of the University are authorized and directed to execute and deliver a Change Order to the ESA in substantially the form submitted to the Board with such changes, omissions, insertions and revisions as shall be approved by the President or Vice President for Finance and Treasurer of the University, and to do and perform such other acts and to execute such further documents and certificates and to take such other actions as may be necessary, required, appropriate or convenient to implement the purposes of the ESA as amended. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

Agreements with Non-Collegiate Organizations

Ms. Cali moved that the Board of Trustees hereby authorize Montclair State University to offer college credit bearing courses in conjunction with or under contract with non-collegiate organizations and directs the President and/or the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs to do and perform such acts and take such actions as may be necessary or otherwise required in connection with same. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

NJDEP Grant

Ms. Cali moved that the Board of Trustees certifies that it grants its permission to apply for, and accept, a \$63,479 grant award from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection to fund the project entitled “**DEVELOPING A WETLAND BASELINE AT THE WATERSHED SCALE**” and authorizes the Director of Research and Sponsored Programs to take all actions necessary to effectuate same. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

FY 18 Managerial Salary Program

To accommodate salary increases for individual managers retroactive to July 1, 2017, Mr. McGoldrick moved that the University make available an overall pool of dollars not to exceed 3.0% of the total FY17 managerial salaries. Individual salary increases shall be based on merit and market conditions. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

Motion to Amend the Agenda

Mr. McGoldrick moved to amend the agenda to include a resolution regarding Presidential Compensation.

Presidential Compensation

Mr. McGoldrick moved that, in recognition of President Susan A. Cole's continuing outstanding leadership, performance, accomplishments, and service to the University, the Board of Trustees approves, effective July 1, 2017, a salary of \$440,000 and a performance bonus equal to 10% of her FY 2017 salary. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

Matters Presented by the Chair - Mr. Hiltzik

Mr. Hiltzik reported that the Trustees met closed session prior to the meeting during which time they reviewed the minutes from June 8, 2017, received an update on legal matters, and discussed contract negotiations and met in Executive Session regarding the President's annual performance evaluation.

Matters Presented by the President – Dr. Susan A. Cole

Dr. Cole took note of the superb new facility for the School of Communication and Media in which the Board meeting was taken place, thanked Dean of the College of the Arts Daniel Gurskis for his continued leadership to the College, and noted the faculty contribution to the design and planning for the School of Communication and Media building. Dr. Cole also recognized Vice President for University Facilities Shawn Connolly and Vice President for Information Technology Candace Fleming for their roles in bringing the building to fruition. Dr. Cole announced that effective July 21, 2017, the University had been designated a Public Research University by act of the New Jersey Legislature and acknowledged the contributions of the University community to the University's growth and success, which ultimately led to the University receiving the designation. Dr. Cole also thanked Director of Government Relations Shivaun Gaines for her tireless efforts in ensuring that the legislation would be passed and Trustees LaRossa and Mullen for their efforts. Dr. Cole announced that the University had received the Middle States Accreditation Final Report, which was extremely positive. The University's next accreditation review will take place in 2025-26. The Council for the Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs also reaccredited the University's four counseling programs for another 8 years. Dr. Cole congratulated Dean Tamara Lucas and her entire team. Dr. Cole welcomed Acting Dean of the College of Science and Mathematics Dr. Lora Billings, who returns to the University from her time at the National Science Foundation, and announced that Dr. Kenneth Sumner, the former chair of the Psychology Department, has been appointed as Acting Associate Provost. Finally, the President indicated that enrollment for Fall 2017 is very strong, with registration exceeding last year's numbers at the same point in the year by approximately 1,000 students.

Motion to enter closed session: Mr. Hiltzik made the following motion, which was seconded and approved unanimously:

Be it hereby further moved pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-13 that the Montclair State University Board of Trustees shall enter into Closed Session prior to the next scheduled Public Session to discuss the following pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-12.b: 1) pending litigation filed against the University; 2) personnel matters; and 3) other matters which may arise consistent with N.J.S.A. 10:4-12.b.
