President Cole introduced several new faculty members and incoming freshmen to the University Community.

Union Report

Professor Richard Wolfson spoke on behalf of AFT Local 1904, thanking the professional staff, specialists and librarians who worked during the summer break to ensure the University was ready to welcome students back for the Fall semester. He applauded the University for organizing free flu shots for the campus community and sought clarity on the process used to appoint new faculty and commented on the status of Statewide AFT union negotiations. Professor Wolfson also commented on the proposed Strategic Plan to be considered by the Board of Trustees and urged the Board to invest in its human capital.

Presidential Compensation

Ms. Cali moved that whereas the Board conducted its annual evaluation of the President's performance and determined that she has continued to demonstrate transformative leadership to the University, that in recognition of President Susan A. Cole's continuing outstanding leadership, performance, accomplishments, and service to the University, the Board of Trustees approve, effective July 1, 2019, a salary of \$471,000 and a performance bonus equal to 20% of her FY 2019 Salary. The motion was seconded. Douglas Kennedy noted his abstention for the record and the motion was approved unanimously with the noted abstention.

Dr. Cuss commented on Dr. Cole's record of success, which includes sustained growth in academic standing, quality of faculty, enrollment, and applications, and thanked her for her continued work to increase state funding.

FY 2020 Managerial Salary Program

Ms. Cali moved that to accommodate salary increases for individual managers effective July 1, 2019, the President shall make available an overall pool of dollars not to exceed 3.5% of the total for FY19 managerial salaries. Individual salary increases shall be based on individual performance and market conditions. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.
