#### MATTERS PRESENTED BY THE CHAIR

Dr. Cuss reported that in closed session the Trustees reviewed the minutes from July 20, 2021, reviewed legal matters and discussed personnel matters.

#### MATTERS PRESENTED BY THE PRESIDENT

President Koppell expressed his excitement in joining the dynamic University community and stated that he had spent the first month of his administration touring the campus, hosting town

halls, meeting with students, faculty, staff, and engaging with community partners. President Koppell outlined his vision of the University becoming the leading public service educational institution in New Jersey. President Koppell provided a Covid-19 update, stating that there was a vaccine mandate for students, the vast majority of faculty and staff had been vaccinated, and the campus had largely returned to normal operations. There was a masking policy in place and the University owed it to the students to provide as safe and normalized educational experience as possible. He also thanked for the collaborations in seeking a mutually agreed upon vaccination policy for faculty and staff.

#### Union Report

AFT President, Professor Richard Wolfson opened his remarks acknowledging those that lost their lives on September 11, 2001. He then welcomed the University's new librarian, Danianne Mizzy, as well as the new faculty and instructional and clinical specialists, and professional staff. Professor Wolfson welcomed President Koppell and committed help the President meet his intention that Montclair State University be a model for labor/management relations. Professor Wolfson expressed the desire to have greater interaction with the Board of Trustees.

Finally, the University has approved a remote work policy, which is designed to aid in the recruitment and retention of University staff.

#### Union Report

He then acknowledged that the University was included in the US News and World Report global university rankings, and remarked that that it was quite an achievement. He welcomed the new managers and staff being appointed. Professor Wolfson asked for greater detail regarding the University's audited financial statements and asked that they be made easily findable on the University's web page. He asked for greater communication with the community regarding the flexible work policy and, in particular, to consider the impact on faculty and staff when the work arrangements are changed due to a weather or other emergency. Professor Wolfson offered his assistance in designing aspects of the newly required Board of Trustees training and urged everyone in the University community to vote on election day.

#### MATTERS PRESENTED BY THE PRESIDENT

President Jonathan Koppell thanked the faculty, staff, and students for their collective effort in protecting the health of the university community by committing to a high rate of vaccination and masking. The communal effort has allowed a fully in-person semester. Enrollment for the spring and fall semesters appears to be strong. Vice President for Enrollment Management Wendy Lin-Cook deserves public recognition for her hard work in this regard. The University has distributed more than \$60 million in pandemic related funding to the students, including \$13 million this month. The University hosted 9 community college presidents in the hopes of building on and fostering new partnerships. Lastly, congratulations to Sam Mills family for his posthumous induction into the Pro Football Hall of Fame.

#### Union Report

AFT President, Professor Richard Wolfson thanked the Trustees for making these meetings fully accessible by providing in person and zoom options. This allows increased transparency which is an important tool in engaging the community. Professor Wolfson also expressed concerns related to COVID-19. #### MATTERS PRESENTED BY THE PRESIDENT

President Koppell reported that the University held its annual Commencement ceremony at Metlife Stadium on May 20<sup>th</sup>. There were over 10,000 people in attendance to watch the University confer over 4,500 degrees. The University also held 9 convocation ceremonies on Sprague Field. President Koppell thanked Nicole Fleming who did a wonderful job orchestrating these events. University Development has raised more than \$11 million year to date and are on pace to have their best fundraising year to date. The University has submitted more than 77 corporate and foundation proposals this year with 50 being awarded and had significant increases in major gift. Over 200 attendees came together to be celebrated for their giving to the University with special recognition given to Josh Weston, former Chairman of ADP. Enrollment for the upcoming year looks quite strong, particularly among our first year class, which expects to be the largest in the University's history. Vice President Wendy Lin Cook has been working hard on both the recruitment and retention fronts and her work is paying dividends.

#### MATTERS PRESENTED BY THE PRESIDENT

President Koppell thanked Governor Murphy and the Legislature for investing in Montclair State University's students – raising student funding to \$3,750 per student.
