President Koppell shared the University's recent national rankings and highlighted recent grant awards which brought the University's total new research funding to \$19.3M.

The President also thanked the staff volunteers who organized the University's Halloween event for students at Yogi Berra Stadium. President Koppell then recognized the inaugural season of Women's Flag Football starting in Spring 2026 and those student-athletes competing in the Fall NCAA playoffs in Men and Women's Soccer and Volleyball.

The President provided an update on University Police staffing and announced the second lecture in the Montclair250: The American Experiment series, featuring State Attorney General, Matt Platkin. The President closed by thanking the dedicated faculty and staff and wished all the best in preparation for the end of the semester.

UNION REPORT

AFT President Laura Field recognized the efforts of faculty and staff in bringing the University's mission to life by hosting exciting events throughout a busy semester. President Field asked that the Board and University leadership consider ways to support AFT members by training management on the collective bargaining agreement, increasing transparency in decision-making, valuing faculty and staff input, and inviting participation in University planning.

President Field next expressed the AFT's support for the intent and spirit of the University's new Mission Statement and commitments, welcomed the new faculty, and congratulated the professor emeriti.

President Field closed by encouraging people to vote in the upcoming November election and wishing everyone a happy Thanksgiving.
