□ Physiology and Hygiene Requirement - <i>Deadline: By Clinical II Audit Deadline (see below)</i> The New Jersey Department of Education has a Physiology and Hygiene requirement for teaching certification candidates. This requirement can be satisfied by completing appropriate coursework or by passing the <i>Health Knowledge Test</i> available through the Center of Pedagogy. Please see your Teacher Ed. Advisor or consult Canvas for more information on how to fulfill this requirement.	
□ Substitute Teaching License Requirement - <i>Deadline:</i> 3 months after completing 60 credits Students are required to have a New Jersey Substitute Teaching License before starting the Professional Sequence. You are eligible to obtain a Substitute Teaching License once you have earned 60 credits. Students are advised to start this process as soon as possible it can take up to three months to complete. Consult Canvas or Teacher Ed. Advisor for more information.	
□ Clinical Practice I & II Application - Deadline: March 1st for Fall Clin. I & II / Oct. 1st for Spring Clin. I & II Date Completed: Students must complete the Clinical Practice I & II Application the semester before they plan to start Clinical I. The application is an online eligibility survey that informs the Office of Clinical Internships that you are ready to start your Clinical year and prompts the to initiate the placement process.	
□ Praxis Subject Assessment - <i>Deadline:</i> By Clinical II Practice Audit Deadline (see below) The New Jersey Department of Education requires all candidates to achieve a minimum score on the Praxis Subject Assessment. Information regarding which test to register for and how to register is available on <i>www.ets.org/praxis</i> . Students are urged to take the required Praxis test as early as possible and to report both passing and non-passing scores to the Center of Pedagogy.	 ce
□ Clinical Practice Audit - Deadline: July 15th for Fall Clinical I & II/ December 15th for Spring Clinical I & II The Office of Teacher Education Advisement and Retention will conduct an audit to verify your eligibility once you submit your application for Clinical Practice I & II. You can expect to receive formal notification from the Center of Pedagogy regarding your aud results.	lit
□ edTPA- <i>Deadline:</i> Completed during Clinical Practice II All candidates seeking initial teaching certification in New Jersey are required to complete the edTPA in order to become certified. The edTPA is a performance-based assessment that asks candidates to demonstrate their understanding of how to plan for instruction implement instruction, and assess instruction.	ion
