Important Notes and Deadlines

- Physiology and Hygiene Requirement - *Deadline: By Undergraduate Graduation*** Date Completed:
The New Jersey Department of Education has a Physiology and Hygiene requirement for teaching certification candidates. This requirement can be satisfied by completing appropriate coursework or by passing the *Health Knowledge Test* available through the Center of Pedagogy. Please see your Teacher Ed. Advisor or consult Canvas for more information on how to fulfill this requirement.
- Substitute Teaching License Requirement - *Deadline: 3 months after completing 60 credits*** Date Completed:
Students are required to have a New Jersey Substitute Teaching License before starting the Professional Sequence. You are eligible to obtain a Substitute Teaching License once you have earned 30 credits. Students are advised to start this process as soon as possible as it can take up to three months to complete. Consult Canvas or Teacher Ed. Advisor for more information.
- Praxis Subject Assessment - *Baseline Score Deadline: December 15th (Year II Fall Semester)*** Date Completed:
The New Jersey Department of Education requires all candidates to achieve a minimum score on the Praxis Subject Assessment. Information regarding which test to register for and how to register is available on www.ets.org/praxis. Students are urged to take the required Praxis test as early as possible and to report both passing and non-passing scores to the Center of Pedagogy.
- Apply for Graduation with Bachelors Degree - *Deadline: Set by University (Year II Fall Semester)*** Date Completed:
Apply for graduation with your Bachelors Degree in NEST. The deadline date will be set by the University and communicated to via email and Red Hawk News.
- Graduate School Fast App - *Deadline: February 15th (Year II Spring Semester)*** Date Completed:
The link to the Fast App will be emailed to you by the Graduate School in January. You are not required to pay the \$60 application fee or attend the Graduate Open House. Required Transcripts will be received by The Graduate School automatically.
- Clinical Practice I & II Application - *Deadline: March 1st (Year II Spring Semester)*** Date Completed:
Students must complete the Clinical Practice I & II Application the semester before they plan to start Clinical I. The application is an online eligibility survey that informs the Office of Clinical Internships that you are ready to start your Clinical year and prompts them to initiate the placement process.
- Comprehensive Exam - *(Year III Fall Semester)*** Date Completed:
Register for GRAD CMP-66 in the Spring semester of Year II to complete the Comprehensive Exam in the Fall semester of Year III.
- Apply for Graduation with Masters Degree - *Deadline: Set by University (Year III Fall Semester)*** Date Completed:
Apply for graduation with your Masters Degree in NEST. The deadline date will be set by the University and communicated to via email and Red Hawk News.
- Clinical Practice Audit - *Deadline: July 15th for Clinical I / December 15th for Clinical II (Year III)***
The *Office of Teacher Education Advisement and Retention* will conduct an audit to verify your eligibility once you submit your application for Clinical Practice I & II. You can expect to receive formal notification from the Center of Pedagogy regarding your audit results.
- NJ Teacher Certification Application Process - *Deadline: April (Year III Spring Semester)*** Date Completed:
Instructions to complete the surveys for your teacher certifications will be provided by the Office of Clinical Internships during Clinical II.

Clinical I Eligibility: *The following requirements must be met by the Clinical Audit Deadline*

- Full Admission to Teacher Education Program** - All Provisions must be met if applicable
- 3.25 or higher Overall and Major GPA**
- B- or better in all Professional Sequence Courses**
- On track to complete all coursework prior to Clinical II**
- Substitute Teaching License** - Emailed to clinicalinternships@montclair.edu
- Mantoux (TB) Test** - Results emailed to clinicalinternships@montclair.edu (*Consult Canvas for more information*)

Clinical II Eligibility: *The following requirements must be met by the Clinical Audit Deadline*

- All of the above**
- Completion of all graduate coursework (except Clinical II courses themselves)**
- Praxis Subject Assessment with Passing Score**
- A PDF copy of your Praxis Subject Assessment Score Report should be downloaded to your computer and then emailed to TEAdvisement@montclair.edu and your Program Advisor no later than the Clinical Audit Deadline.
 - Passing **OPI** required for *Spanish, French, Italian* or *TESL*; Passing **WPT** for *TESL*; Passing **LTTC** for *Latin*.
