

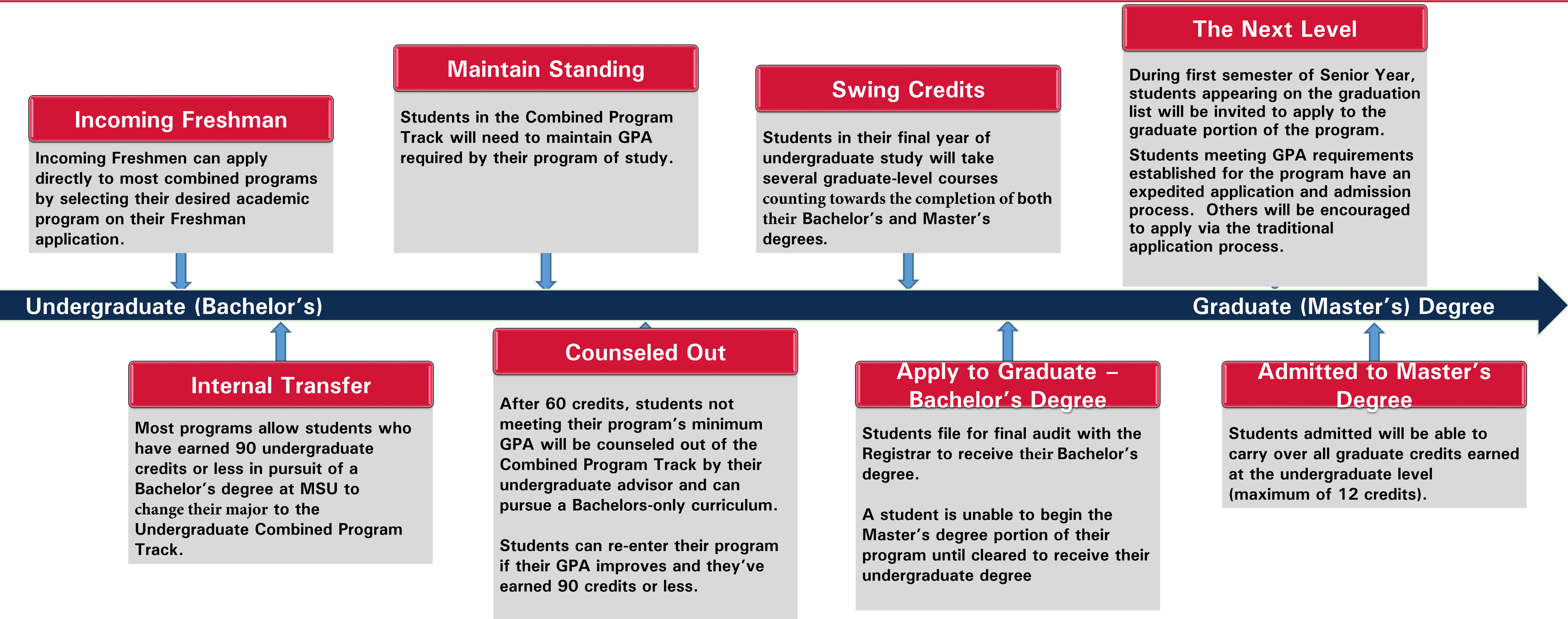


Combined Programs Lifecycle



Background:

Combined degrees allow students to count graduate credits toward their bachelor's degree and their graduate degree which allows for the completion of both degrees in less time. A combined degree program allows students to complete "swing credits" (6-12 depending on the program) while enrolled as an undergraduate, which count for both their bachelor's and master's degrees.



- Benefits of Combined Programs:**
- Save up to \$7,000 in tuition and fees.
 - Graduate with both degrees 12-18 months earlier.
 - Ease and transparency of admissions process.
