The Montclair State University Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship Program is dedicated to recruiting, preparing, and supporting new **science teachers** for New Jersey's high-need public secondary schools. This project is funded by the National Science Foundation and offers two years of scholarships equal to the amount of New Jersey in-state tuition and fees, as well as an annual stipend of \$3000 to undergraduate chemistry, physics, earth science, and biology majors admitted into the MSU Teacher Education Program.
