Paint by numbers

- 1.) Find a spot outside
- 2.) Put your poster paper on the ground. Make sure it lays flat
- 3.) Each person takes turns
 - a. Dip your paint brush in the cup of paint
 - b. Lightly splash the poster paper from a standing height. We want the paint to fall in a scattered way onto the poster paper. No blotches—we want identifiable dots of paint.
 - c. Stand back as others do the same
- 4.) Once everyone on your team has splashed until the paper has about at least 100 dots. This may mean everyone goes once or twice.
- 5.) Fill in the following table:
