
Graduate Education Fast Facts

- Positive impact on your future career earnings
 - There is over a 17% difference in average salary for those with a Master's compared to those with a Bachelor's degree according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics
- The <u>U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics</u> sites a direct correlation between higher levels of education and lower unemployment rates
- •According to the <u>U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics</u>, 18% of all jobs will require a master's degree by 2022



Graduate Education Impact on Earnings

- •According to the 2016 U.S. Census, just over 33% of all adults in the United States has earned a Bachelor's Degree or higher.
- •Average earnings for those with a high school degree was \$35,615.
- •Average earnings for adults with a bachelor's degree was \$65,482.
- •Average earnings for those with an advanced degree was \$92,525.



- 3. Begin and submit your online application
- 4. Once you have submitted the application, you'll be able to view and upload the specific documents that are required to complete your application
- 5. The \$60.00 application fee will be automatically waived for webinar attendees



- 6. Upload or send any Additional Documents (vary by program):
 - Unofficial transcripts from any U.S.
 college or university you have attended
 - Standardized tests: GRE or GMAT (or Praxis for teaching programs)
 - Personal Statement/Essay
 - Letters of Recommendation
 - Resume



Students with an international academic background need to submit a course-by-course transcript evaluation by any member of NACES.org or by EducatedChoices.com.

Applicants who have earned their undergraduate or graduate degree from an institution where English is not the official language of instruction will be required to submit proof of English proficiency. TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language), IELTS (International English Language Testing System) or Duolingo English Test scores are accepted.
