

Payment Plan Options

Montclair State University offers a payment plan that allows the student's bill to be divided up into several smaller payments throughout each semester.

- Students have the option of 5 payments, 4 payments or 3 payments for each semester.
- Students can enroll for one (1) semester at a time and may have one (1) active plan per semester.
- Payment plans are interest free and available for a modest fee of \$30.00 USD.

How to Apply for Admission

- Submit the Online Application
- Upload your Personal Statement/Essay
- Transcripts/Academic Evaluation
- Official transcripts must be submitted by your school. (International college transcripts must be translated into English and may require a document evaluation by a NACES-member evaluation company.)
- Freshman: Minimum 2.75 GPA (4.0 scale)
- Transfer: Minimum 2.5 GPA (4.0 scale)
- English Language Proficiency Test Scores
- TOEFL minimum score of 70
- IELTS minimum score of 6.0
- SAT Evidence Based Reading and Writing minimum score of 480
- ACT English minimum score of 22
- Duolingo English Test minimum score of 95
