Post Senior Year of Work:

MUTH 465, Internship in Music Therapy, must be taken following completion of all course work. The internship must be completed within 2 years of the conclusion of regular academic course work, according to national regulations. A minimum of a grade of C- in all music therapy courses is required. Successful completion of the curriculum and of the internship qualifies one to sit for the examination to become a Board-Certified Music Therapist.
